A heritable connective
tissue disorder.

Main symptoms:

- Extremely fragile tissue, often with facial skin folds
- Atrophic scarring, poor wound healing
- Navicular/ inguinal hernias
- Hypermobile joints, increased risk of (sub)luxations

Caution:

- Please treat and move me with extra care. I have an increased risk of (sub)luxations and bleeding.
- Local anesthesia may be less effective or ineffective.
- Be mindful of possible hernias.
- Sutures should be done by a specialist.
- Be aware of jaw dislocations and a fragile cervical spine when intubating.
- Wound healing is delayed, be cautious of invasive procedures.
